You and your child may be eligible to participate if:

Your child will wear some equipment on their head during some of these tasks. This is called **EEG.**

WHAT IS EEG?

Electroencephalography (EEG) is a **noninvasive** neuroimaging technique. **No pokes, pricks, or anything painful is involved.**

Your child will wear a cap that looks and feels like a swim cap. We will then apply some gel to the scalp to help the sensors read your child's brain waves.
