Approval of Minutes: Minutes of the March 3, 2017 meeting were approved by automatic consent.

New Business

1. BME 305, Introduction to Biomechanics, (U), new course. Church (Jang) moved to approve. Motion was denied (0,6,0). Committee feedback to the BME Dept: Why is Dynamics not a pre-req for this course? There seems to be too much overlap with content from Statics and Dynamics. The committee suggests to reconsider the course with dynamics as a prereq and then make the topics in this class more advanced. The suggestion is to modify topics listed in syllabus to show a growth beyond Statics and Dynamics or define a curriculum strategy for this course as it was currently proposed. Another comment was the potential need for any lab content in the course.
2. IndEng 550, Control of Automated Manufacturing Systems, (U/G), prerequisite change, course description change. Jang (Xu) moved to approve. Motion Carried
3. IndEng 598, Connected Enterprise Systems, (U/G), new course. Xu (D'Souza) moved to approve. Motion carried. Comment: The course name is a trademarked phrase. Is that allowable?
4. Industrial Engineering – Curriculum Modification to specify all IndEng courses between 400 and 699 are approved technical electives. Jang (Xu) moved to approve. Motion carried.

5. CompSci 241, C Programming for Embedded Systems, (U), new course, (possible cross-list with ElecEng 241) Jang (Xu) moved to approve pending modification of the CAR form to show CS240 as a prerequisite (P) and not concurrent (C). Motion carried.
6. CompSci 458, Computer Architecture, (U/G), prerequisite change. Xu (Jang) moved to approve. This approval will also apply to ElecEng 458 (listed jointly with CS 458) pending passage by the Electrical Engineering Dept. Motion carried.
7. CompSci 481, Server-side Internet Programming, (U/G), prerequisite change. Wang (Xu) moved to approve. Motion carried.
8. OPC 2356, Web Development Certificate, change of program requirement. Comment: CS Dept reached out to SOIS regarding the change and they agreed that it would be beneficial. Jang (Xu) moved to approve. Motion carried.
