Approval of Minutes: December 1, 2017 meeting were approved by automatic consent.

New Business

- 1) BME 305, Introduction to Biomechanics (U), new course. Seifoddini (Wang) moved to approve. Concerns were raised about lack of a Statics and/or Strength of Materials prerequisite for the course. Dr. Misra stated the goal of BME is to adopt the "Core" engineering program once clearly defined and updated. The workload policy as started on the submitted syllabus should be revised to better reflect APCC expectations prior to approval by the CEAS faculty. Motion carried.

engineering students learn some bread-boarding skills (outside of the major) or getting

experience with 3D CAD (within the major). Please provide information back to Church
