Georg Essl is a Research Professor in the Department of Mathematical Sciences at the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee and recipient of a Guggenheim Fellowship. He holds a Ph.D. in Computer Science from Princeton University. He has been affiliated with the University of Michigan, Deutsche Telekom Laboratories, MIT Media Lab Europe, University of Florida, and HyperWave. His current research focuses on mobile phones as musical instruments, sound synthesis and tangible interactions. He founded and directs the Michigan Mobile Phone Ensemble (Michigan MoPho) and is also co-founder and co-director of the Stanford Mobile Phone Orchestra (MoPho), and is founding director of the Berlin Mobile Phone Orchestra (Berlin MoPho).
