# <u>Interview with Kathryn (Record)</u> <u>Ziegler and Bryan Ziegler</u>

Greendaler asks: How did you two first meet?

Kathryn replies: We met at **Tim Zielke**'s

Christmas party. I remember standing in the kitchen and seeing Bryan across the way. I was at the party simply to be my brother's (**Matt Record**) designated driver, so I leaned over to him to ask who that (Bryan) was. I sang in chorus throughout school and was in an *a cappella* group in high school! When I moved to Madison I joined the **Yahara River Chorus** for a little bit, then of course had to join **Forward** since I saw how much work went into making it a reality!

Bryan says: The pandemic, in combination with living further apart than we wanted to be (I was in Pewaukee, Kathryn in Madison) definitely made it harder on our already less-than-coordinated work schedules. We decided to FaceTime every night during the pandemic, and that really brought us closer together and strengthened our relationship as it was growing.

Kathryn adds: The pandemic started just about 3 months into us dating. The first month of the shutdown was the hardest for us since we didn't get to see each other. FaceTiming every night definitely helped us to grow our relationship and showed

me just how much he meant to me. You had to be very intentional with who you saw during the pandemic, and Bryan was one of my top priorities.

Greendaler asks: We know you got married on June 25, 2023, out east somewhere. Can you tell us a bit about that day?

The song was "Dance With Me" by Mandi Mapes. I arranged the song and sang the instrumental parts while Kathryn sang the melody. It took some people a while to realize it was us singing, but it was so special when it dawned on them!
